- Phase I Design and Implementation
  - Construction began on May 11
  - Ribbon cutting July 11
- ✓ Phase I A Breeze Machine Installation
- Phase II Design and Implementation
  - Preliminary Concept Completed
  - Estimated Completion: FY 2023




## **BUS SHELTER & AMENITIES UPDATE**



#### **CLAYTON BRT UPDATE**

- ✓ MARTA BRT status 15th Amendment commits in service 2026; Planning underway in FY2021
- The Atlanta-Region Transit Link Authority (ATL) recommended Clayton BRT for state bond funding
- Clayton BRT scored well on Geographic Equity scenario



# MARTA RIDER INITIATIVES

## HOPE ATLANTA PARTNERSHIP

- Being unsheltered is not a crime
  MARTA receives complaints from customers about the unsheltered riding
- ✓ Partnership with HOPE Atlanta
  - Yearlong program; space in Five Points Station
  - Teams of Hope Atlanta caseworkers and MARTA Field Protective Specialists (not MPD officers) formed
  - Teams travel throughout the system, focusing on "hotspots" in stations and other facilities
  - ✓ Goals: service connections for 80; housing connections for 50


## MASKS ON THE SYSTEM

AJC () 💙 🖓 🕤 🖸

 In June, 35% of MARTA customers were wearing masks
 In early July, MARTA announced masks would be required and that MARTA would distribute 2 million masks

- In 535 shifts, 417k masks have been distributed
- ✓ Mask wearing is ~90%



- Two corridors for premium transit have been identified
- ✓ Our goal is to create a user- friendly model ordinance for Transit Oriented Development in Clayton and South Fulton County communities
- This is needed to help each jurisdiction become TOD ready
- ✓ TODs are critical to the success of these corridors by attracting density and intensity



## MOUNTAIN VIEW EXAMPLE


- ✓ Mountain View Overlay Zoning District scored very well on MARTA's parcel-level analysis for TOD readiness
- ✓ Incorporation of transit-supportive land use policies in the Mountain View Overlay District including
  - ✓ zero-foot set-backs
  - ✓ reduced parking requirements
  - ✓ 8'-10' wide sidewalk requirements
  - ✓ higher density allowed
- ✓ Will help Clayton be more competitive for federal grants and support development that will make transit successful




#### **AIRPORT STATION REHABILITATION**



#### COLLEGE PARK STATION REHABILITATION

- Repaving of entire entryway paver area on east and west entry points
- ✓ Rehabilitation of all adjacent landscaping
- ✓ Repair and repaint of all perimeter iron picket fencing and replace concrete base
- Replacement/ painting of all parking light poles
- ✓ Installing new backlit MARTA signs for branding improvements
- ✓ Replacement of all station signage
- Repair major station platform elements: pavers, widescreens, benches
- Replacement of boarding edges along platform



#### ESCALATOR/ELEVATOR REHABILITATION

- ✓ Majority of MARTA's escalators/elevators are 36-40 years old
  - Average lifespan of commercial elevator/escalator is 25 years
- ✓ August 2016 the MARTA Board of Directors approved a 10-year, \$217 million contract for:
  - $\checkmark$  Maintenance of all escalators and elevators and
  - ✓ Rehabilitation of 116 escalators and 111 elevators
- ✓ Construction work began June 2017
- ✓ To date, 39% of elevators and 21% of escalators have been
  - rehabilitated





#### STATION RESTROOM UPDATE

- ✓ To prevent the spread of COVID-19, only Five Points, Lindbergh and end-of-line station restrooms remained open
- ✓ As virus is prolonged, MARTA has reopened all station restrooms with enhanced cleaning at 17 stations with agents
- East Point Smart Restroom conversion will be first to enter construction, planned late October
