✓ Program approved by voters in 2016 by an overwhelming majority of 71%.

✓ After successful passage of the referendum, MARTA and the City of Atlanta executed a robust program of community engagement to establish guiding principles and the project list.

✓ A list of 73 projects was narrowed to 17 priority projects and adopted by the MARTA Board in 2018.

### November 2016

More MARTA referendum approved by 71% of voters

Enhanced bus service immediately implemented

#### **More MARTA Atlanta Guiding Principles**



Balance portfolio of transit projects using multiple transportation modes.



Increase mobility for workers to and from major job centers.



Enhance commute predictability with dedicated and managed lanes and other technology.



Create a layered, integrated transportation network.







#### **Guiding Principles (continued)**



Prioritize city investments while integrating into regional transit networks.



**Enhance safety and access to transit centers and MARTA stations.** 



Enhance ease of use and transfers within the network of transit options.



Create last-mile connectivity via circulators, multiuse paths and sidewalks.



Partner with neighboring jurisdictions to leverage transit projects.

✓ In 2019, the MARTA Board adopted a sequencing and governance plan that was codified into an IGA between MARTA and City of Atlanta in 2020.

 Every More MARTA Atlanta decision is made jointly between MARTA and the City of Atlanta.

✓ Includes a process for modifying list, knowing that project list would evolve with changing conditions.
















### 2019 Sequencing Plan









### **Approach to Resequencing & Program Prioritization**


In addition to applying the nine guiding principles, each project was reviewed based on the following criteria:

- Committed state and federal funds
- Competitiveness for additional state and federal funds
- Project delivery phase (consideration of funds already invested)
- Overall public and stakeholder support for the project, public engagement and outreach held








#### What does Tier 2 mean?

- In 5 years or less another sequencing assessment will be performed (per IGA).
- Current expenditures and funds availability will be reviewed. Future projects will be re-estimated.
- All assumptions will run through financial model.
- Projects may be separated into further tiers depending on funds availability and anticipated project costs.

### **Summerhill Bus Rapid Transit (BRT)**

PHASE: CONSTRUCTION
Expected Service Start Date: 2025

MARTA's first Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) line will connect the Atlanta BeltLine, Peoplestown, Summerhill, Capitol Gateway, and South Downtown. The Summerhill BRT line is funded through a Federal TIGER Grant and the More MARTA sales tax.

### Cleveland Avenue & Metropolitan Parkway ART Projects

PHASE: FINAL DESIGN
Expected Service Start Date: 2025

The Cleveland Avenue & Metropolitan Parkway Arterial Rapid Transit (ART) projects will provide a new type of service mode to MARTA's existing transit systems. The new mode will enhance local service offering more premium amenities (e.g., real-time arrival signage) and optimized stop locations to provide more efficient and frequent service.

#### **Bankhead Station Platform Extension**

PHASE: FINAL DESIGN

**Expected Completion Date: 2027** 

The Bankhead Station Platform Extension project will elevate the current platform from a two-car train capacity to an eight-car train capacity. Planned development in the area will increase the reliance on and need for this expansion. The project will be done in collaboration with the MARTA Bankhead Station Master Plan. The Bankhead Station Platform Extension is funded through the More MARTA sales tax and state funds.

#### **Streetcar East Extension**

PHASE: FINAL DESIGN
Expected Service Start Date: 2028

The Streetcar East Extension project is the first extension of the existing downtown Streetcar since it opened in late 2014. This project runs along Edgewood Avenue to the Atlanta BeltLine at Irwin Street and up to Ponce de Leon Avenue. Final design continues to advance considering possible effects to adjacent properties, existing utilities, vehicle and operational needs, neighborhood accessibility, and proposed stop locations. This project has advanced with continued coordination between MARTA, the City of Atlanta, and Atlanta BeltLine, Inc.

#### **Five Points Transformation**

PHASE: CONCEPTUAL DESIGN

**Expected Completion Date: 2026** 

The Five Points project is a transformation of the aboveground plaza, surrounding streetscapes, and station plaza level, including the removal of the existing concrete canopy. This work will create a new and inviting urban space above the station, improve accessibility in and out of the station, and improve bus operations. The project is funded by the MARTA core penny, the More MARTA Atlanta program, a federal grant and state funds.

### **Campbellton Corridor Bus Rapid Transit (BRT)**

**PHASE: CONCEPTUAL DESIGN** 

**Expected Service Start Date: 2028** 

This project will improve connectivity, accessibility, and mobility in southwest Atlanta through bringing Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) to the Campbellton Corridor. The corridor links the Greenbriar Mall area to the Oakland City MARTA Rail Station. This multimodal investment will enhance the service area and transform how residents travel to jobs, services, and other points of interest while supporting the community's growth and development for years to come.


#### **Clifton Corridor Bus Rapid Transit (BRT)**

PHASE: CONCEPTUAL DESIGN

**Expected Service Start Date: 2028** 

MARTA is advancing Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) for the Clifton Corridor. The project will reduce peak end-to-end transit travel times in the corridor from over one hour to about 30 minutes. Peak transit travel times between Lindbergh Center and Emory University would be reduced from about 30 minutes to 11 minutes.
